## ECA MARKS

It is a requirement of all learners to participate in extra-curricular activities (ECA), as part of the Life Orientation curriculum. Learners receive marks for their contribution in this respect, be it sporting, first aid, chess, cultural, etc.

As of 2018, learners in ALL grades have the ability to log volunteering/community service hours towards their ECA mark. They are required to fulfil a minimum of 12 hours of voluntary work per term. Those in matric may log 10 hours per term, due to their workload.
